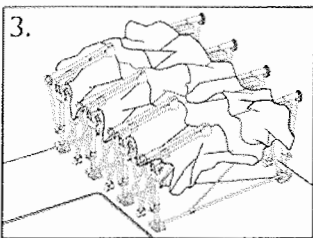
## Instructions for EZ BED™ Set-up:



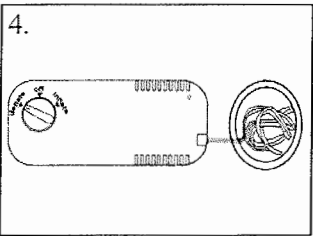
- Unzip the storage case, make sure the unfolded 3 panel covers of storage case are laid flat on the floor to allow the bed frame to expand smoothly.



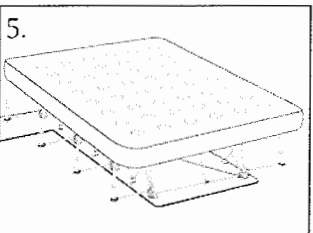
- Do not set anything on top or around bed during inflation cycle.
- Bed will expand approximate 6ft. in length and 2ft. on left and right. (Clear space accordingly)
- Plug pump into a polarized 230V AC outlet.
- Turn switch to "Inflate" position, Airbed will begin to inflate.



- Airbed-frame will automatically extend from its storage case.

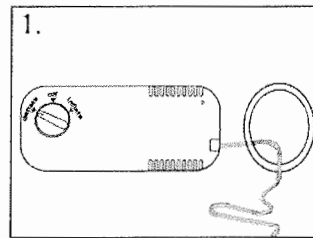


- Pump does not turn off automatically.
- When Airbed reaches desired firmness, turn switch to "Off" position.
- Unplug and store the cord in the "Cord Storage Pocket".

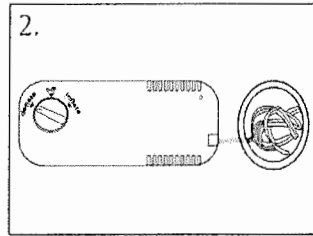


- EZ BED™ is ready for use.

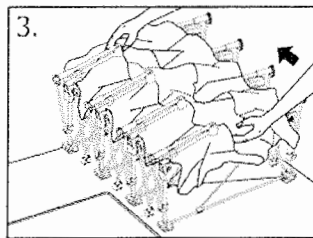
## Instructions for EZ BED™ Storage:



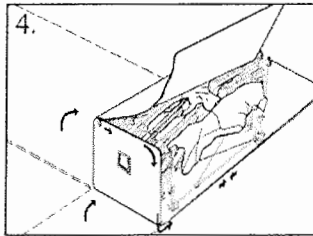
- Clear area & bedding and other articles prior to deflation.
- Plug pump into a polarized 230V AC outlet.
- Turn switch to the "Deflate" position.
- The pump will completely remove all the remaining air.



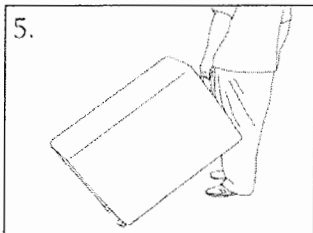
- Pump does not turn off automatically.
- When deflation is completed, turn switch to "Off" position then unplug from power outlet and store cord in "Cord Storage Pocket".



- Gently lift up Airbed frame by its foot end and push it back into its storage case.



- Zip-up storage case for storage.



- Handle and wheels are located on the storage case for easy and convenient transport.
